### EXAMPLE PROJECT

In FY2022, **EDA invested \$3,036,465 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) – Indigenous Communities funds the Coeur d'Alene Tribe** to support the installation of a water supply system to replace defective water utilities infrastructure in the town of De Smet, Idaho. The Coeur d'Alene Reservation is located in the northern part of Idaho and the improved infrastructure will deliver a quality water supply that will create conditions that are economically favorable for the Plummer, Idaho region. The project work consists of replacing an aging and undersized water system infrastructure and water storage reservoirs.
